

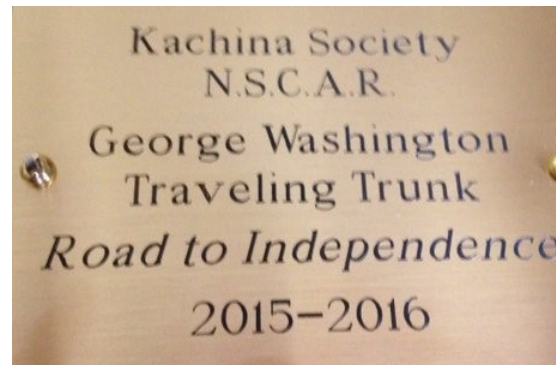


Scheduling Information
